ABOUT TRIPLE R RANCH

The Triple R Ranch is a non-denominational Christian facility and operates according to the beliefs set forth in our “Statement of Faith.” We ask that groups respect our beliefs and agree not to teach or promote any philosophy or lifestyle in opposition to those beliefs. Should this prove an obstacle for any group considering the use of the camp, we would appreciate their courtesy in choosing another site to host their event. We are a camp for children in the summer months, and a Retreat facility from Labor Day through Memorial Day, offering a variety of activities along with horseback riding lessons in the spring and fall, as well. The Triple R has an “Old West” Ranch theme and our facilities have been designed to maintain that atmosphere.

DESCRIPTION OF LODGING

Ponderosa Retreat Center, has four sleeping areas each of which has two, two-room, “cabins”. The cabins each have 8 double bunks, two of which are full sized beds, providing sleeping for 16 persons. There are two - 32 bed sleeping areas with separate bath and shower facilities on each side of the building. This enables us to serve two separate groups of up to 64 at the same time. A separate speaker's suite is also available in the facility, as well as a kitchen with ice machine, an indoor climbing wall, and a racquetball / wallyball court. The Ponderosa retreat center brings our total beds to more than 325. The reservation includes 2 free hours usage of the wally ball court.

**45 person minimum required to reserve the Ponderosa for 1 night or 35 person minimum to reserve for 2 nights.*

“**Virginia City Hotel**” is a western two-story dormitory style building that accommodates/sleeps, 30 guests on each level or a total of 60. The Hotel is equipped with indoor bathrooms as well as central heat and air-conditioning. The “Caribou Café” meeting room is part of the Virginia City Hotel, with a fireplace and kitchenette, is included with the reservation.

40 per minimum required to reserve the Hotel for 1 night or 30 person minimum to reserve for 2 nights.

The “**Cabins**” are rustic one room cottages that sleep up to 12 people. Each are furnished with wooden bunk beds, and have heat and air-conditioning. There are 13 cabins, in two separate areas on camp. Each cabin area has a central bath facility with heat and hot showers. An amphitheater and campfire site is available in each area. A meeting room is also included with the reservation of our cabins.

MEETING ROOMS

One meeting room is provided with the reservation of a retreat. It is the responsibility of each group to set up and take down any equipment related to their group's activities. Media equipment is available upon request. If you need an additional meeting room the rates are as follows: Ponderosa Main Hall~ call for price. Large room~1st day~ \$150.00; \$100.00 each additional day. Small room~1st day: \$65.00; \$40.00 each additional day.

FOOD SERVICE

Meals are prepared fresh and served cafeteria style. We make every effort to serve in a timely manner as we are often serving several groups. Groups are required to contact us with their accurate meal count three business days prior to their visit. We allow groups to continue to grow up until their arrival. In the event you arrive with fewer people reported, you will be billed for 95% of the number given or your guaranteed minimum, whichever is greater. **Meal times are as follows:**

Breakfast~ 8:15 am; Lunch ~12:15 pm; Dinner ~5:30 pm

Friday: Dinner~ 6:30 pm

We appreciate your courtesy in allowing time to arrive at the dining hall at least 5 minutes prior to the meal.

Provision for special dietary needs is available for an additional fee. Please request these when giving us your final count.

Vegetarians - \$3 additional per meal/per person

Gluten-free - \$4 additional per meal/per person

REBOOKING INFORMATION

There is a thirty (30) day rebooking window for all retreats. Deposit is due at time of booking. If next year's deposit is paid with the current balance, an additional \$50 credit will be applied.

GENERAL RESERVATION INFORMATION

The Retreat Coordinator will often book several groups at a time. If you wish to have “exclusive use” of the facilities please contact the Ranch office. “*Exclusive Use*” of the facilities refers to general use of the buildings and grounds but does not prohibit the ranch from conducting Horseback Riding Lessons, scheduling day activities, or housing & feeding our staff.

INSURANCE

The Triple R Ranch carries insurance for liability. Your coverage is primary for accidental injury and illness. In the event of injury, leaders are responsible to determine if EMS services are necessary and act accordingly. For all injuries, the Triple R must be notified after proper care is initiated. We recommend that each participant have a “permission to treat” form, signed by their parent or guardian, on file with the leader of the retreat. A “Certificate of Insurance” is requested listing Triple R Ranch as additional insured.

GUARANTEED MINIMUMS

A Guaranteed Minimum (GM) number of participants for your event is required. This is the number of people that your group will be financially responsible for in the event of a low turn out.

DEPOSITS

The deposit is required within two weeks for reservations made within 6 months and in three weeks for reservations made more than 6 months in advance to confirm request. The deposit is deducted from the total cost of your retreat. Full payment is due at check-in but may be extended until the following morning for you to confirm your group’s attendance.

Please make your payment with a check or cash. Credit cards may be used to pay your deposit. A \$20 convenience fee will apply.

CANCELLATIONS :

The advanced planning needed to schedule retreats makes it difficult to fill cancellations. If you must cancel, please call the Triple R office immediately. After hours messages are welcome.

USE CODES

- ☆ Guests agree to respect Triple R Ranch beliefs as set forth in the Statement of Faith. We are a Christian establishment and ask that you refrain from dishonorable language and conduct.
- ☆ The sponsor must be in control of retreat activities with chaperones as needed for proper supervision.
- ☆ Fires are restricted to designated areas. Guests should only use wood provided and under no circumstances is anyone to cut down trees or shrubs.
- ☆ Unless prearranged, quiet hours begin at 11 pm.
- ☆ Please do not use tape on painted services like doors or nails and staples in the walls . Ball playing and “rough housing” are not allowed in the buildings. Guests are responsibility for damages to facilities.
- ☆ Smoking is limited to graveled areas and never allowed in buildings or wooded areas.
- ☆ Thermostats should be regulated by leaders, and should be turned off at departure.
- ☆ These areas are off limits without ranch supervision: the kitchen at the Lodge, the Barn, any corrals, fenced pastures, maintenance areas, box cars, the pool (except as contracted), private residences, family cemetery, ropes courses and the Homestead (the yellow house at the front of the Ranch).

The Triple R Ranch offers a unique variety of activities designed to provide something for all ages. The activities described below are complete with applicable age restrictions and group minimums. Initial reservations need to be made over the phone to confirm availability. During your initial phone reservation we will discuss the number of sessions needed and your options.

Archery: Introductory level archery with recurve bows is offered for age 8 or older. Sessions are 45 minutes in length. **Group size is 10 to 15 persons** per session. **\$6.00 per person**

Barn Tour: We offer a 25 minute enjoyable horse barn presentation. Instructors tailor the tour to the age and attention span of the children. **Group size is 10 to 25 persons** per session. **\$6.50 per person**

Canoeing: This is available to school age children as well as adults. The cost is **\$9.50 per person** for guided experiences and **\$5 per canoe** for groups self-led by experienced leadership of their own. **Group size is 10 to 28 persons** per session.

Challenge Course: Triple R's ropes course involves individual and group physical challenges to build teamwork and personal growth through unique outdoor experiences. Low initiatives seek to create the necessity of working together to complete various elements on the course. The high initiatives emphasize individual perseverance and culminate in an exhilarating zip line ride. Low Initiatives last approximately 3 hours: **\$18.00 per person**. High Ropes Initiatives run 2 to 3 hours: **\$22.00 per person**; combined: **\$35.00 per person**. Open to **Groups of 8 to 36 persons** age 12 through adults. ***Signed release form required.***

Climbing Wall: Two forty foot faces makes this one of our most challenging and popular activities. Open to anyone 8 years of age and older, this activity requires a minimum of 10 to a maximum of 20 per hour. The cost is **\$6.00 per person**. The course is scheduled in hour time slots. ***Signed release form required.***

Indoor Climbing Wall: Our new 23 foot indoor wall with its natural look and feel offers groups an exciting new climbing experience. Located in our Ponderosa retreat center it is usable rain or shine. This activity requires a minimum of 8 to a maximum of 12 per hour. The cost is **\$6.00 per person**. The wall is scheduled in hour time slots. ***Signed release form required.***

Fishing: Cane pole fishing in our stocked pond makes Triple-R fishing memorable. **Designed for groups of between 10 to 15 children (5 to 13 years of age);** 45 minutes in length. The cost is **\$5.50 per person** (for self-led fishing the price is **\$3.00 per person**).

Registered guests may bring their own equipment and fish at no charge. Catch and release is in affect unless special arrangements are made.

Hay Maze: Annually, two new and unique tunnel style mazes are open from **Late September to February**. Our hay maze package includes entrance to **both** mazes, a tractor hay ride and campfire. The mazes are for junior-high age youth to adults. **A minimum of 20 persons required.** The maximum is 200. ***Signed release form required.*** The cost for the package is **\$13.50 per person**. Chaperones not wishing to do the mazes or youth with asthma **\$5.00** (hay ride & campfire only). A self-serve hot-dog meal is optional for an additional **\$5.00 per person**.

Hay Rides: Horse-drawn or Tractor-drawn hay rides, for groups up to 20 - 25 persons per ride, provide a very enjoyable and peaceful experience out in the country. Hay rides and are available Fall, Winter, & Spring. The average cost is **\$3.50 to \$5.00 per person** for these 25 to 30 minute, 1½ mile long hay rides through wooded trails and alongside pastures (additional time is require to board and to exit the wagon). A campfire makes a great addition to your hay ride event. Two draft-horse teams and several tractors, enable us to accommodate large groups.

Tractor hay rides: \$70 per wagon ride until 9:00 PM
(after 9:00 PM: \$90 per wagon ride).

Horse-drawn rides: \$90.00 per wagon ride
(not available after 9:00 PM).

Horsemanship Badges: Girl Scout: Junior "Horse Fan" and Cadet / Senior "Horse Sense" badge work is taught on Saturdays during the school year. **Required minimum is 6 girls. Cost is \$10 per scout / \$8.00 if the troop adds a trail ride. Trail ride minimum is 8 riders.** (badges must be ordered from Council).

Activities: Continued

Horseback Rides: Our scenic western style trail rides are our signature activity. Our horses are carefully selected for safety and dependability. Our guided, walking horseback rides run approximately 30 - 40 minutes along wooded trails and around our pastures. Advance reservations are available for groups **of 10 or more**. Trail ride capacity is 15 persons per ride Saturday in the morning and 20 per ride Saturday in the afternoon and mid-week. Children must be 8 years old to control their own horse (provision can be made for a child 5-7 years old to join a ride). Helmets are provided for our guests and required for all minors. Cost: Groups **\$20.00 per person**; Groups of less than 10 persons may call in, midweek, to reserve space for the upcoming Saturday. Cost: **\$25.00 per person**.

Leather Craft: Participants receive a piece of leather shaped to become a bookmark, wristband, or key-chain. They use letters and picture stamps to create their own design. After embossing the leather, they bring their pictures to life with colored markers. Lastly, a brown stain and clear coating finishes the craft. This activity lasts about 45 minutes. Open to groups of **10 to 20 children** at least 6 years of age. **\$5.00 per person**.

Pony rides: Children **age 2 to 7** may enjoy a ride led by our staff (usually 2 times around a riding ring). These are available whenever there are trail rides being offered. To schedule a specific time requires a **minimum of 10 children**. Half hour reservations can accommodate a maximum of 20 children. Cost is **\$6.00 per person**. Hourly rental is provided for large group events.

Racquetball / Wallyball: Our Ponderosa retreat center includes a racquetball / wallyball court. Cost: **\$20.00 per hour** with 2 hour minimum. Retreat groups may schedule 2 hour sessions for the special rate of **\$20.00**. The wallyball is provided. Racquetball equipment not provided.

Riflery: Introductory level 22 caliber riflery target shooting is available for 8 years old and older for groups of 8 to 15. The ranch has both adult and youth size rifles. **The cost is \$9.50 per person**.

Skate Board Park: Our Skate Park has a 3ft. half pipe, 3ft. and 5ft. quarter pipes, a fun box multi-ramp, and rail. Guests must bring their own equipment; a helmet is required. Cost: **\$25.00 per hour and \$60.00 for the afternoon (up to 4 hours)**.

Swimming: 25 meter swimming pool complete with two diving boards and a 60 foot pool slide is available on a seasonal basis. Lifeguards can often but not always be arranged for by the camp. Guests are welcome to bring their own certified guards. **Two lifeguards are required for groups of over 50 persons and each group must provide one adult watcher for every 25 persons**. Modest one-piece bathing suits are required (Ladies who do not have a modest one-piece suit may wear a long, dark-colored T-shirt over their suit). The pool rents for **\$150.00 first hour; \$100.00 each additional hour** (Daily rates are available). When Lifeguards are provided, fees are **\$20.00 per guard per hour**.

Additional Amenities:

Basketball Court: This is open to our guest groups on a shared basis unless specifically reserved. It is available for rental at **\$50.00 for 3 hours**.

Campfires: Campfires make a great addition to any visit. The Triple R Ranch offers several scenic sights with benches or picnic tables, your fire prepared and waiting for you, additional wood to last 2 to 3 hours, and rubber handle skewers to save you the trouble of making or buying your own. Campfires as described are **\$40.00**.
