Camps:

ADVENTURE- Campers rotate through skill areas each morning with their cabin mates. Each day holds a different schedule of skill areas (See Skill Areas below.) Afternoons are spent at the pool, skate park, climbing wall, playing games, at an optional elective (additional fee - see below) or hanging out with friends at the Trading Post. Bible Discovery hour and evening all-camp programs round out the day.

MINI-CAMP- is a shorter version of Adventure Camp.

DAY CAMP- Campers enjoy Adventure Camp while spending their overnights at home.
Monday through Friday. (8:00 AM - 5:30 PM Mon-Thur / 8:00 AM - 6:00 PM Friday)

RANCH HAND CAMP- A little bit of work and a little bit of play make up a great week at Triple R. 15-17 year olds can enjoy a week serving in each work area of the Ranch including: Kitchen, Maintenance, Barn, and Trading Post / Program. Daily seminars and activities focus on team-building and leadership. All will enjoy participating in nightly worship and Bible studies. This program serves as an introduction to serving on our Junior Staff (Participation in this program does not guarantee a position on Staff.) Participation is limited to two weeks per summer.

Horsemanship Electives: Additional Fee (see front of form)

HORSEMANSHIP TRACK- This is for campers who want to spend more time with horses and go further in their horse handling skills. Two hours each morning are spent at the stables learning to ride and take care of horses.

PRIVATE RIDING LESSON- A one-on-one horseback riding lesson tailored to the individual's needs (One per camp session)

Morning Skill Areas:

Adventure Campers travel with their cabin mates through a schedule of exciting Skill Areas. The following is a sample of what to expect:

Horse Sense – Learn what is involved in grooming, saddling and staying safe around horses.

Horseback Riding – Every camper gets the opportunity to mount up and take a ride.

Critter Corral – Meet our small farm animals and learn why each one is important.

Roping – Learn how to hold and swing a rope so you can lasso your target.

Archery – Campers master the bow and arrow with time at the archery range.

Nature study by the pond – Become more aware of our environment as you study living organisms.

Outdoor Living Skills – Learn to read a compass and enjoy a nature scavenger hunt.

Camping skills – Learn to build a campfire, prepare shelter and enjoy some roasted marshmallows.

PVC Challenge- Work together with your cabin mates to design and build the tallest structure.

Canoeing – Campers get on the river to explore and perfect their strokes.

Water Fun – Enjoy the Water Slide, swimming, diving boards and games at the pool.

Challenge Course – Cabins work together to overcome the challenge of our low ropes course.

Climbing Wall – Scale to the top of our 40 ft. high climbing tower and ring the bell.

Wally Ball – This fun indoor game is like volley ball in a racquetball court.

Knock Out – Enjoy learning this dodge ball game from Israel.

Old Time Games – Learn to play some old fashioned playground games.

Guinness Book – Be the person who beats the camp record at some crazy and fun challenges.

Afternoon Electives: Additional Fee (see front of form)

Campers may choose these afternoon activities for an extra fee:

Leather Craft- Stamp and stain a leather craft to take home with you from camp.

Riflery- Campers learn to handle and fire a rifle safely.

Archery- Campers master the bow and arrow with time at the archery range.

Golf Cart- With adult supervision, campers can take one of our Golf Carts for a spin around camp.

Jiu-Jitsu- A modern self defense system. The emphasis is on grappling, ground fighting, and stand-up self-defense moves.

High Challenge Course- (Ages 12+) Climb high through the challenge course and take a ride down the zip line.

Financial Policy

A \$100 deposit is required to register, of which \$25 is non-refundable, and \$75 is refunded in the form of Triple R Gift Certificates if written notice is received 30 days prior to registered session. For cancellations made within 30 days of registered session, there is no refund of the \$100 deposit. If for any reason you must cancel, a written notice must be submitted to our office. Session changes require a \$15 processing fee (waived until May 1, 2012) accompanied by written notice.
