Have a heart for Children, ages 8-14? Apply for a counselor position.

1. Counselor

The direct ministry to the campers is carried on primarily through these counselors. They live with campers, teaching them activity classes and sharing experiences, all of which are designed to develop relationships which will give credibility to the Bible classes which they teach. Counselors must have completed one year of college. Counselors minister in two-person teams in a cabin setting to campers ages 8 -14.

Have a heart for teenagers? Apply for a “support” position.

Support Staff

Support Staff live and work with the Jr-Staff (High School aged staff). Support Staff work in their designated area and serve as small group leaders. Small Groups consist of two Sr. Staff members and three to six Jr. Staff members. After work each day small groups do meet together for team building activities, Bible Study and fellowship time. Those interested in working with and ministering primarily to teenagers should apply in the following areas.

2. Lifeguard - Lifeguards are responsible for the day to day upkeep of the pool. They teach the water fun skill area each morning and oversee swim time in the afternoon. This person must have up to date Lifeguard certification.

3. Kitchen - The kitchen staff work under the direct supervision of the Food Service Director and are responsible for institutional cooking and total meal preparation.

4. Ranch Hand - This position requires knowledge of or willingness to learn practical skills in maintenance of buildings, pool upkeep and yard work

5. Barn – The barn staff work under the direct supervision of the Horsemanship director to take care of over 60 horses at Triple-R, They are responsible for feeding, grooming, tacking and daily barn chores. Depending on training and experience, they may lead trail rides, assist or teach riding classes.

6. Camp Store - This person will open and manage the Trading Post (Camp Store.) They clean, organize store, order, stock, maintain updated camper accounts, prepare and deliver camper care packages.

7. Photographer - This person is responsible for taking pictures of all activities around camp each day. They will create a daily Parent’s Page on our website for camper and staff parents. They are also responsible for the sorting and delivery of mail.

8. Skate Park Manager - This person should enjoy teaching children how to skateboard. Your responsibilities will include upkeep of all equipment, teaching skateboarding or assisting in other skill areas each morning during skill time and opening the skate park two hours each afternoon for “open” skate time.
