

What to Expect Once Camp Begins

Sunday:

Mornings – Everyone should attend the church of their choice. Staff churches and departure times will be posted.

3:00PM – Staff meeting in the Lodge

3:30PM – Report to your work area

Kitchen staff to kitchen.

Barn Staff and Ranch Hands begin parking and delivering luggage.

Lifeguards clean pool and help registrar.

Skatepark and BMX Staff stay in their areas to check-in camper equipment.

Counselors meet together and then report to their assigned cabins.

Trading Post cleans and gets TP ready to open at 4:30-8:00.

Other Support Staff reports to registrar to help with check-in.

5:00PM – Campers begin check-in and supper begins in the Lodge

7:00PM – Swim Test, Camp Tours and Cabin Pictures

- Jr. Staff Ministry Team meets

8:00PM – Fireside: Involves singing, camp rules and cabin cheers.

- All Support Staff go to Jr. Staff meeting which begins at 8pm in the Café.

9:00PM – Campers report to cabins

10:30PM – Jr. Staff Curfew

11:00PM – Sr. Staff Curfew

Monday – Friday - Daily Schedule Activity Descriptions:

Support Staff - Somewhere between 5am and 8am – Support Staff will be reporting to their work area. Each area starts at a different time depending on what needs to be done before Breakfast

Before you report to work in the morning, your bed should be made and the area around your bunk cleaned. Each department begins work at different times. Regardless of the time your living area should be clean.

Before 8AM - Cabin Clean-up:

Counselors are responsible for delegating duties and overseeing the cleaning of their cabin. Part of camp is helping campers to learn how to be away from home and taking care of their things. Counselors should not participate in any cleaning other than that of their own bunk. A check off list will be provided.

8:00AM - Morning Watch:

Counselors and Campers - meet at the boy's amphitheater for a time of singing and the Bible Study for that day will be introduced.

Support Staff – Each department will have devotions with their staff.

8:20AM – Flag Raising:

Campers should line up by cabin in front of the Lodge. A selected counselor or camper will lead everyone in the Pledge of Allegiance. Campers should remain in line until they have been called into the Lodge.

8:20AM – Breakfast

- After breakfast support staff report to their area for the day

9AM-1PM – Skill Areas:

Hourly from 9-1pm; daily. Classes begin on the hour and every cabin travels to four different skill areas each day. Counselors travel with their cabin and they teach skill areas. Counselors get one hour off during this time.

Each class ends 10 minutes before the hour. The Camp Store is open during this time for drinks and snacks.

1PM – Lunch – Line up as a cabin outside the Lodge and wait to be called in. Support staff can enter and sit at their assigned tables.

1:45PM – Rest Hour:

Campers should report to their own cabins and remain in their own bunks. Counselors should encourage campers to sleep but may allow reading, quiet games and letter writing.

Support Staff - The Pool is open for you to cool down and enjoy.

2:45 – 5:15 – Prime Time:

Counselors work with their campers to decide the activities they would like to do as a cabin. The pool, Trading Post, Cabin Challenges, Riflery, Game Room or Skate Park.

Counselors should stay with their campers during Prime Time. Since there are two of you, your campers can be in two different places at the same time. One of you should be with each group. Enjoy this time with your campers. Have a great time playing.

Cabin Challenges: Your cabin has a chance to earn point towards the coveted Bull Horn Award. These are optional and you'll be given a list of appropriate challenges.

5:30PM – Supper - Line up as a cabin outside the Lodge and wait to be called in.

Tuesday night is Cabin Night. Your food will be on your tables in a cooler. Pick up your food and decide on a location for your cabin to enjoy a picnic.

Support Staff eat in the Lodge. Your sandwich fixings will be buffet style.

Thursday night is banquet. The dress is western if you have it and the tables are a bit fancier than other nights.

6:30PM – All Camp

Each evening a different activity will be planned that all of camp participates in.

Monday – Water Rodeo or Pool Party

Tuesday – Picnic and Melodrama presented by staff.

Wednesday – Skit night. Camper, Counselors and Support Staff take part.

Thursday – All Camp Soccer Game.

8:00PM – Bible Hour:

Counselors and campers meet in the large room at the new building. A "Pastor/Teacher" will open the lesson each day. The teacher will dismiss everyone to their cabin to finish Bible Hour with their Counselors.

8:00-10:00pm(Nightly) – Jr. Staff Ministry begins and all Support Staff participates. Different activities and Bible Studies are planned each night. This is for everyone who is not a Counselor or CIT. During time off from your work area you can do skill areas and other activities with your small group. Support Team Leaders will help you work out a schedule.
